### Children's Ministries

**Sunday School**—Nursery - 5th grade Bible lessons and application in small class settings. 9:30 a.m.

**Children's Choir**—Teaching Biblical principles through singing, musical activities and movement. Little Kids' Choir is for children 4 years - 1st grade. Big Kids' Choir is for 2nd - 5th graders. 6:00 p.m.

**Awana**—a program of activities, Bible stories and Bible memorization for children three years through fifth grade. Held on Wednesday nights during the school year.
